

**MINUTES**

July 13, 2009  
North Town Hall

Mayor Jeffcoat called the regular meeting of Council to order at 6:00 p.m. and declared a quorum. Present were Council members Binyard, Lane and Gleaton. Also in attendance were Mark Fallaw, Chief of Police, and Carrie Garrett, Town Clerk. Councilman Drew was unable to attend.

Mayor Jeffcoat led council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffcoat welcomed visitors.

Councilwoman Lane made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 8, 2009 meeting, seconded by Councilwoman Binyard, and upon vote minutes were approved.

- o Jeffcoat reviewed the financial statement for June, 2009.

Special Presentation:

New Business:

- o Jeffcoat discussed that the Community of Character Trait for June is Integrity.
- o Todd Bremner from TDS made a presentation on the Town Hall's telephone system. TDS will no longer lease our phone system to us, leaving us with no maintenance or support for the current system. Councilwoman Lane made a motion to purchase the new telephone system which cost will be reflected as a \$25 increase per month on the telephone bill. Motion was seconded by Councilwoman Binyard and upon vote carried.

Mayor's Report:

- o Jeffcoat reminded everyone that the election will be held November 3<sup>rd</sup> for two council positions. Statement of Candidacy should be filed at the North Town Hall July 13<sup>th</sup> – July 24<sup>th</sup>.
- o Jeffcoat mentioned Sgt. Herlong, asking to remember him and his family as he has had three family deaths recently.
- o Jeffcoat also mentioned that the Town's policy on picking up dead animals out of the roadway will have to change due to an order by DHEC not to dispose of animals on Town property.
- o Jeffcoat gave an update on the playground – two proposals have been received and are being reviewed.

Public Comments:

- A citizen asked questions regarding the Town's policy on animal control.

There being no further business, Councilwoman Lane made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and meeting was adjourned at 7:12 p.m. Councilwoman Binyard closed the meeting in prayer.
