

MINUTES
Town of North
June 8, 2009
North Town Hall

A public budget hearing was held at 5:45 p.m. giving the public an opportunity to voice any issues regarding the 2009-2010 proposed budget.

Mayor Jeffcoat called the regular meeting of Council to order at 6:25 p.m. and declared a quorum. Present were Council members Drew, Binyard, Lane and Gleaton. Also in attendance were Mark Fallaw, Chief of Police, and Carrie Windham, Town Clerk.

Mayor Jeffcoat led council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffcoat welcomed visitors.

Councilwoman Lane made a motion to approve the minutes from the May 11, 2009 meeting, seconded by Councilman Gleaton, and upon vote minutes were approved.

Water/Sewer Report:

Mr. Jeffcoat presented the water / sewer report for May, 2009 (copy attached).

Police Report:

Chief Fallaw reviewed the North Police report (copy attached).

Street Scape Report:

Mayor Jeffcoat announced that the project is completed with the exception of signage.

Old Business:

- o Jeffcoat reviewed the financial statement for May, 2009.

New Business:

- o Jeffcoat discussed that the Community of Character Trait for May is Leadership.
- o Motion was made by Councilman Drew to amend the budget to include \$24,000 for a new patrol car, seconded by Councilwoman Lane, and up on vote (4 – 1) the motion carried.
- o 2009-2010 Budget – Motion was made by Councilwoman Lane to accept this as second reading of the 2009-2010 budget and accept the budget as presented with one amendment, seconded by Councilwoman Binyard and upon vote carried.

Mayor's Report:

- o Jeffcoat reported that he is working on getting estimates for painting of the water tank.
- o Jeffcoat reported that the building at the water tank is framed up and coming along.

Public Comments:

- o Reverend Wright announced that the North Day of Prayer will be Saturday, November 14th from 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m., and requests use of the pavilion and invites the public to attend.
- o A citizen commented that the Streetscape project looks good.

- A citizen requested assistance with getting a street light put up at the corner of Savannah Highway and Pou Street. There used to be a light there but it was taken down during the Highway 321 work project and was never put back up.

There being no further business, Councilman Drew made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and meeting was adjourned at 7:06 p.m. Reverend Wright closed the meeting in prayer.

The next Council meeting will be held on Monday, July 13, 2009 at 6:00 p.m.
