

MINUTES
Town of North
March 8, 2010
North Town Hall

Mayor Jeffcoat called the regular meeting of Council to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Council members Drew, Jones, Lane and Washington. Also in attendance were Carrie Garrett, Town Clerk and Chief of Police Mark Fallaw.

Mayor Jeffcoat led council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffcoat declared a quorum and welcomed visitors.

Councilwoman Lane made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 8, 2010 meeting, seconded by Councilman Drew, and upon vote minutes were approved.

Public Comments:

Rick ___ with Leary Construction Company introduced himself. Leary Construction Company had the lowest bid on repainting the water tank (inside and outside). He answered questions of Council members regarding the process of repainting the water tank.

Water/Sewer Report:

Mr. Jeffcoat presented the water / sewer report for February, 2010 (copy attached).

Police Report:

Chief Fallaw reviewed the North Police report (copy attached).

Old Business:

- o Jeffcoat reviewed the financial statement for February, 2010.
- o Councilwoman Lane made a motion to hire Leary Construction to do the one-time painting inside and outside. Motion was seconded by Councilman Drew and upon vote carried.

New Business:

- o Jeffcoat discussed that the Community of Character Trait for March is Honesty.
- o Second reading was given of the Animal Control Ordinance. Motion to accept as second reading was made by Councilwoman Lane, seconded by Councilman Washington and carried.
- o Motion was made by Councilwoman Lane to approve the Animal Control Ordinance, seconded by Councilman Jones, and upon vote carried.
- o Motion was made by Councilwoman Lane to approve the Resolution Authorizing the Town of North to Enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County of Orangeburg Regarding Enforcement Services Pertaining to The Animal Control Code, seconded by Councilman Washington, and upon vote carried.
- o Motion was made by Councilwoman Lane to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Enforcement of Animal Control Code, seconded by Councilman Jones, and upon vote carried.
- o Councilman Drew made a motion that the Town of North donate \$300 to the North Community Athletic Club to benefit the little league, seconded by Councilman Jones and upon vote carried.

Mayor's Report:

- o Mayor Jeffcoat mentioned that the Town of Woodford will be hosting their Hummingbird Festival Friday, March 19th and Saturday, March 20th.
- o Jeffcoat discussed the need for the Town to have a designated Town Attorney and discussed that Norway's Town Attorney, Robert McCurry has agreed to provide services to the Town of North on

an "as needed" basis at the rate of \$200 per hour. Councilwoman Lane made a motion that Robert McCurry be designated as the Town Attorney for the Town of North, seconded by Councilman Drew, and upon vote carried.

- Jeffcoat also informed Council that the cracks in the concrete at the basketball court are still being worked on and that no money has been paid on that project yet.

Public Comments:

- Reverend Wright mentioned that he will be traveling with mission work and asked for the community's prayers.

There being no further business, Councilman Drew made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and meeting was adjourned at 6:37 p.m. Reverend Wright closed the meeting in prayer.

The next Council meeting will be held on Monday, April 12, 2010 at 6:00 p.m.
