

**MINUTES**  
Town of North  
May 10, 2010  
North Town Hall

Mayor Jeffcoat called the regular meeting of Council to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Council members Drew, Jones, Lane and Washington. Also in attendance was Chief of Police Mark Fallaw. Town Clerk Carrie Garrett was unable to attend.

Mayor Jeffcoat led council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffcoat declared a quorum and welcomed visitors.

Councilwoman Lane made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 12, 2010 meeting, seconded by Councilman Jones, and upon vote minutes were approved.

Public Comments:

Water/Sewer Report:  
Mr. Jeffcoat presented the water / sewer report for April, 2010 (copy attached).

Police Report:  
Chief Fallaw reviewed the North Police report (copy attached).

Old Business:

- o Jeffcoat reviewed the financial statement for April, 2010.
- o Councilwoman Lane made a motion for Second Reading and to approve the Ordinance changing Zoning Ordinance, seconded by Councilman Washington and up vote carried.

New Business:

- o Jeffcoat discussed that the Community of Character Trait for May is Cleanliness.
- o Councilwoman Lane made a motion to accept first reading of 2010 – 2011 Budget, seconded by Councilman Washington and upon vote carried.
- o Councilwoman Lane made a motion to accept first reading of Petition for Annexation, seconded by Councilman Jones and upon vote carried.
- o Councilman Drew made a motion to put padding on the fence at the basketball court at a cost of \$500, seconded by Councilman Washington and upon vote carried.

Mayor's Report:

- o Mayor Jeffcoat announced that the fence at the basketball court has been moved back ten feet on both sides.
- o Mayor Jeffcoat discussed the need for padding on top of the fence because there have been reports of people having been pinched.

Public Comments:

- o A concerned citizen asked about a particular piece of property (where Amerigas used to be) that is overgrown and what can be done. Mayor Jeffcoat indicated that he was aware of the problem and has been in contact with the County about it, but will do so again.
- o A concerned citizen asked about Oliver Road being blocked where residents cannot get down the road. Chief Fallaw explained that area is outside of the Town Limits and outside of our

jurisdiction. Mayor Jeffcoat stated that Sheriff Williams was supposed to be meeting with him in the near future and Jeffcoat would mention the problem.

- Concerned citizens expressed concern over drivers speeding through neighborhoods in town (seemed to occur mostly on Sunday mornings). Chief Fallaw said he will follow up.

There being no further business, Councilman Drew made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and meeting was adjourned at 6:57 p.m. Rev. Wright closed the meeting in prayer.

The next Council meeting will be held on Monday, June 14, 2010 at 6:00 p.m.
