

MINUTES

North Town Hall

Mayor Jeffcoat called the regular meeting of Council to order at 6:00 p.m. Present were Council members Jones, Lane and Washington. Also in attendance were Chief Mark Fallaw and Town Clerk Carrie Garrett. Councilman Drew passed away on September 3, 2010.

Mayor Jeffcoat led council and visitors in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Jeffcoat declared a quorum and welcomed visitors.
